

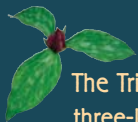


MEET OUR CREW...

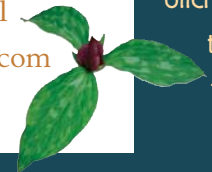

What does hand-crafted joinery mean?

Hand-crafted joinery refers to the age-old method of converting timbers into frame components using hand-operated tools and equipment. We add the human touch that melds the natural beauty of wood with your living environment.

In addition to crafting new homes, we specialize in the restoration and replication of historic timber frame buildings including barns and public buildings. We also construct commercial buildings and specialty frames such as pergolas, pavilions, and architectural timber elements.

DESIGN...

The open floor plan common to timber frame buildings allows for much flexibility in how your living space is created. Working closely with you, our design and engineering team will ensure the integration of your design specifications into your timber frame. Built for durability, longevity, and energy efficiency, timber frames are adaptable to most any living space you can envision.



WOOD...

Trillium Dell Timberworks can obtain and work with almost any type of wood you choose. Our most frequently utilized timber species are oak, Douglas fir, pine, ash, walnut and cherry. We also have excellent resources for securing reclaimed timber from older structures.



ENCLOSING...

Timber frames are often enclosed using structural insulated panels (SIPs). SIPs are foam-core panels with oriented strand board permanently adhered to both inner and outer faces. Finishes such as drywall or wood paneling can be used on the interior. Any style of siding can be applied to the outside including; brick, stone, wood and stucco. Timber frames also work exceptionally well with wall infill systems such as straw clay.



FINISHING...

The timbers for your frame are planed for a crisp appearance before they leave our shop. Once on site, the frame can be finished with any oil or stain you select. Often our frames are finished with a natural blend of preservative oils and beeswax.
